GOVERNING RULES

The racing rules and regulations of US Sailing shall govern except as modified by the Chesapeake Bay Yacht Racing Association, the ESSA 2024 NORSI and these Race Instructions. As always, the most important rule is to avoid collisions. Sail at your own risk.

OBJECTIVES - This is a new sailing event that will be fun for both racers and cruisers.

PARTICIPATION

All boats are welcome to participate in this free event. Only two crew members can be onboard - no non-sailing guests. All boats will sail Non-Spinnaker.

Autopilots can be used.

Classes - Participants can choose to sail in either the Racing Class or the Cruising Class

Racing Class - This class will include experienced racers and will sail a longer course.

Cruising Class - This class will include sailors who want a fun but largely noncompetitive sail around a preset local course.

Handicap Ratings

The ORR EZ rating system will be used. If your boat does not have an ORR-EZ please report your current or previous PHRF rating. If you do not have a rating, no problem. The Race Committee will assign a fair rating to your boat.
